MOTION: A motion to approve amended Mission and goals. Taimay Jones motioned, motion seconded by Karen Rajtar; motion carries.

Vice President's Report- Aimee Cermak & Karen Rajtar

Currently there are 360 PTSA members. At this point last year there were over 500 members. To be a member doesn't mean you have to volunteer. Two people won the Otterwear raffle, there will be more giveaways throughout the year.

Treasurer's Report- Hailey Chamberlain

MOTION: A motion to approve the 2018-2019 Budget and increase the PTSA Focus Enrichment line item up to \$800. Karen Rajtar motioned, motion seconded by Taimay Jones; motion carries.

The Hawk-a-thon income was increased from \$75,000 to \$85,000 to adjust for not needing to pay for Orange Ruler program fees. The Halloween Bash expense was increased from \$2500 to \$3000 based on spending from last year.

PTSA Focus Enrichment Report- Lindsay Quinn

This year Lindsay Quinn will lead a theatre group in the performance of Disney's The Lion King Experience. There will be 35 speaking roles (double casted) as well as dancers, scenery, costumes, props and stage hand roles. Licensing fees will be funded by the PTSA. There is a one-time fee of \$645 and an additional \$75 is required if anyone wishes to videotape the performance. There will be 11 weeks of rehearsals. One rehearsal per week for vocalists and one rehearsal per week for other roles. Costumes and puppetry will be student created. It is not mandatory to be in choir if participating in the performance, but it would be encouraged.

Secretary's Report- Taimay Jones

The May 2018 General Membership Meeting Minutes were submitted, and no changes were made.

Vice Presidents of Fundraising Report- Andrea Bullock & Lindsey Hatch

Hawk-a-thon timeline and website updates reviewed. A local realtor wants to sponsor a Creekside event. More discussion is needed to determine the best course of action.

Vice Presidents of Volunteers/Programs Report- Ghada Madkour & Krista Wood

The percentage of room parent roles filled is 75%. Volunteers are needed for Picture Day and Halloween Bash. Bank Days are the first Friday of every month. Reflections Art Competition is upcoming. Art docents are needed in many of the classrooms. The Issaquah School District Honk and Wave is on October 5th.
