- Non-profit taxes were filed last month.
- Sales tax will be filed by January.
- Bank Balance is \$142,841.33
- Currently we have \$7868 and \$1350 matching funds from Microsoft and are looking for a total of \$19,184.
- \$20 cash Hawk-a-thon donation came in this week.
- It is expected that the fundraising goal for the Hawk-a-thon will be exceeded by \$15,000.
- WSPTSA dues have been paid.
