Creekside Around the World Chair Report- Claudia Barbeyto

- Creekside Around the World will be on Thursday Feb 7th.
- Promotional material designer (Creekside parent) has been contacted.

• Currently there are 442 members of the PTSA. The membership goal is to have 565 members by the end of the year. Teacher member numbers are growing. There are 12 gift memberships available which will be gifted to the teachers who have not signed up yet.

<u>**Grant Awards**</u>- Grant applications were reviewed. See table for information about each grant application. There is \$7500 available for grants and board can go over this amount by \$500 during a board meeting. Any additional grant money may be discussed and allocated at the January General Meeting. There is \$14,830 extra from fundraising which may be used for grants that benefit the entire school.

- Supplemental Support for Second Step Curriculum- All in agreement that \$904.15 be awarded.
- AED Machine in the Office- All in agreement that \$1517.35 be awarded.
- The Lion King- All in agreement that \$1000 be awarded.
- Creekside Breakout EDU- Collaborative puzzle/game that kids play together. All grades can use but the 3rd grade has requested the grant. All in agreement that \$275 be awarded.

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- Gaga Ball Pit- Eagle Scout will be invited to General Meeting to present his idea. All in agreement that this grant may be funded at a later time once building plan is reviewed for safety and longevity.
- Boosting Brains with Books- 5th Grade teachers have a wide range of reading levels and they would like more books. All in agreement that \$513.50 be awarded for one unit of books.
- Communication system- Current equipment is outdated and unable to perform necessary tasks. Grant is for 20 units but 10 units are essential for student safety. All in agreement to award \$3790 to buy 10 units and discuss funding an additional 10 units at the January General Meeting.

- Bank balance \$151,985.34.
- Expenses this last month include a donation for \$1500 to ISF, custodian fees of \$216 for the Halloween Bash, a drama grant for \$2400, an extra \$225 expense receipts from Halloween Bash was paid for beverages, \$5000 was paid for 5th grade camp, a membership fee of \$240 was paid to the state.
- Book fair sales were down from the previous year. This year the approximate total sales was \$7000 (\$1321.89 of that was cash sales). 50% of total sales is given back to the school in scholastic dollars or points. We will approve as a board to donate scholastic points before the next book fair.
- Sales tax from popcorn sales is due in January.
- A lockbox was purchased and is being installed in the front office by PTSA basket. The cost of this box (\$78) was taken from the Office Supplies line item on the budget. The district encouraged the purchase. President, VPs and treasurer should have a key. The lockbox is for mail and anything financial. Reimbursement checks will need to be mailed or given in person. Chair people will be informed of lockbox usage guidelines. The basket will remain for notes, etc.
- The PTSA promotion roll up banner/sign is up now.
- Thank you notes were written for recent event volunteers and contributors.
- Creekside PTSA notecards are to be made.
