CREEKSIDE YEARBOOK COVER DESIGN CONTEST 2019-2020



We are inviting all Creekside students to submit a drawing in our Yearbook Cover Design Contest!!!!

- ★ The winning selection will be displayed on the front cover of our 2019-20 Yearbook.
- ★ The remaining finalists will appear in a collage on the back cover.

Requirements:

- ✓ Size of the paper: 8 ½" x 11". No other size will be considered.
- ✓ Artwork / Drawing must be arranged in Portrait layout (vertical position).
- ✓ Your drawing must include the school's name (CREEKSIDE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL) and the school year (2019-2020). This is the title of our yearbook, so it should be easily seen.
- ✓ The Artwork/Drawing must be **original artwork done by the student**. It cannot be traced from another source or completed by someone else. No computer images - hand drawings only.
- ✓ Use any medium to create your artwork, but it must be scannable.

How to submit:

- ✓ Write your first and last name, and teacher's name lightly with pencil on the back of your artwork before submitting. Do not put the artist's name on the front of the artwork.
- ✓ Turn in your completed drawing by December 6. Submit the drawing to your child's teacher or drop it off at the School's front office. Late submissions will NOT be accepted.

Judging:

- ✓ Depending on the number of entries, PTSA Board Members may select finalists eligible for voting.
- ✓ The 5th grade class will then vote for the final winning entry.
- ✓ Artists will remain anonymous during the voting period.
- ✓ Judging will be based on originality, creativity, and overall design appeal.

Tips for a successful submission:

- Use **BRIGHT** colored crayons, markers, paints or colored pencils.
- Not a lot of white space - use lots of color (including background)
- When creating your artwork, be careful that your artwork does **NOT** have eraser marks, smudges, unwanted pencil marks, etc.
