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#### Appendix A

**WHEREAS**, dyslexia is a language-based specific learning disability that is neurobiological and hereditary in origin and is unrelated and inconsistent with an individual's intelligence; and

**WHEREAS**, dyslexia is characterized by difficulties with accurate and/or fluent word recognition and by poor spelling and decoding abilities; and

**WHEREAS**, these difficulties typically result from a deficit in the phonological component of language that is often unexpected in relation to other cognitive abilities and the provision of effective instruction; and

**WHEREAS**, secondary consequences of dyslexia may include problems in reading comprehension and reduced reading experience that can impede growth of vocabulary and the acquisition of background knowledge; and

**WHEREAS**, the Office of the Superintendent of Public Instruction has acknowledged that 15-20% of the population, or 1 in 5 students, has a language based learning disability, that dyslexia is the most common cause of reading, writing and spelling difficulties; and

**WHEREAS**, literacy is a skill critical for students to be prepared for academic, occupational, personal and practical challenges of life in a dynamic global environment; and

**WHEREAS**, students with dyslexia face significant barriers to academic achievement and student well-being as a result of their disability; and

**WHEREAS**, the Creekside PTSA is committed to raising the achievement of all learners regardless of varied ability, identifying and removing obstacles to educational advancement and student well-being, providing equitable access and academic support; and

**WHEREAS**, the Creekside PTSA supports the early screening for dyslexia along with a new comprehensive literacy program that provides explicit, systematic and multi-sensory instruction and evidence-based early interventions to meet the needs of students with dyslexia as outlined in Washington State's E2SSB 6162 law, passed in 2018 and to take effect in Fall 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, the Creekside PTSA acknowledges that students with dyslexia benefit from structured literacy that is evidence-based, explicit, systematic, sequential, cumulative, multi-modal and taught with fidelity to mastery, and believes that with the right tools and proper support students with dyslexia can achieve academic success and personal well-being at Creekside Elementary.

NOW THEREFORE, We, the Creekside PTSA Board, proclaim October 2020 as

#### DYSLEXIA AWARENESS MONTH

at Creekside Elementary
